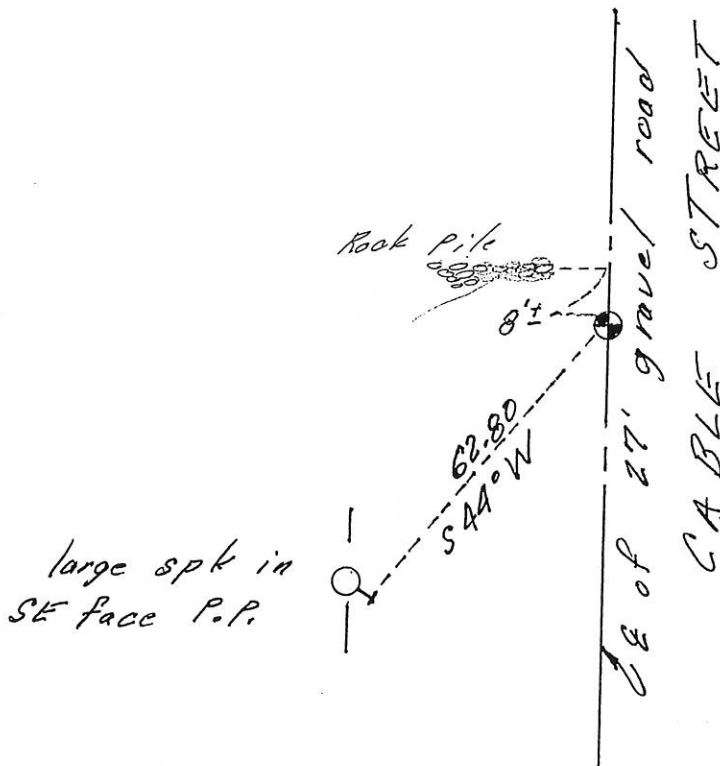

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

East Quarter Corner Section 8, Township 38, Range 25

The original Government post was set by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Daniel Higbee on November 27, 1851 and two bearing trees noted as:

10" White Oak bearing North $42 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ N @44 links

16" Aspen bearing South 41° E @ 42 links

No evidence for the corner or accessories could be found. No records of any subsequent surveys could be found at the Kanabec County offices.

In 2007 while doing a Survey in Section 4 E.G. Rud & Sons located a fence line running east-west at the intersection with the centerline of Cable Street. This fence was no longer in place in 2015. We set a monument at the former location of the fence line and centerline of road. A rock pile on the west side of Cable Street was located 8 feet north of this location. In talking with Jim Schumacher (owner Northeast Quarter Section 8) and Dan Belsheim (owner Northwest Quarter Section 9) they had thought the line was just south of this rock pile. Based on old lines of occupation we believed this was the best evidence for the location of this corner.
