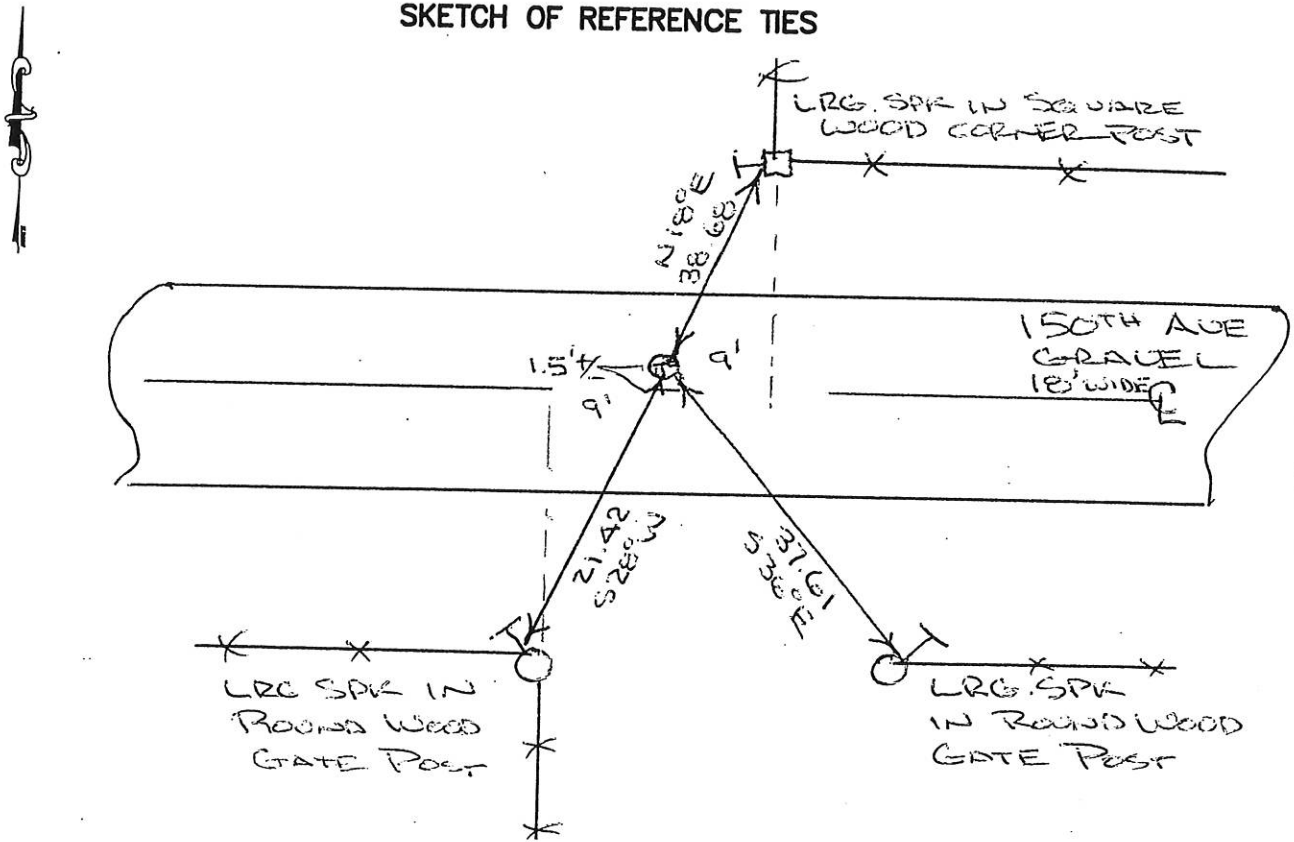

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

North Quarter Section 9, Township 38, Range 25

The original Government post was set by Deputy Surveyor Daniel Higbee on November 27, 1851 and two bearing trees noted as:

12" Sugar Maple bearing N 40° East at 47 links

14" Sugar Maple bearing S 51° West at 6 links

No evidence for the corner or bearing trees could be found.

This corner falls in the centerline of an east-west gravel road. There is a fence line running north and a fence line running south. There is approximately 18 feet between the fences with the northerly fence being the most easterly fence.

In 2007 while doing a survey in the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, we excavated along the centerline of this gravel road. This excavation started at the easterly fence and extended 50 feet +/- westerly to the midpoint between the northeast and northwest corners of Section 9.

No evidence could be found for the location of this corner.

There is a fence line running south along the 1/16 line of the northeast quarter. This fits a location in the middle of the two fences. This also fits the 1/16 line to the west. Therefore we set a #7 rebar with an aluminum cap on the centerline of the road and midway between the fences. Ties were taken and Kanabec County Coordinates established on this position.
