STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

THE ORIGINAL CORNER POST WAS SET BY DEPUTY SURVEYOR DANIEL HIGBEE ON NOV. 28, 1851 AND 2 BEARING TREES ESTABLISHED AS FOLLOWS:

14" PINE BEARING N16°E @ 14 LINKS

12" BURR OAK BEARING S2°W @ 11 LINKS

NO VISIBLE EVIDENCE COULD BE FOUND FOR THE POST OR BEARING TREES..

THERE IS A ROAD OPENING ON FILE ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SEC. 32 DATED JUNE 1919 BUT NO SURVEY WAS DONE.

ON PAGE 27 OF BOOK 2 OF SURVEYS A SURVEY BY JOHN NELSON IS RECORDED FOR THE E1/2 OF SEC 29 DATED MARCH 1904. JOHN NOTED A GOOD GOV'T CORNER AT THE NE CORNER OF SEC. 32 AND THAT HE FOUND 1 BEARING TREE AT THE NW CORNER OF SEC. 32. HE THEN SET THE N1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 32 AND NOTED A 30" PINE BEARING N11°W @ 1.07 LINKS. THIS PINE ISN'T EVIDENT TODAY. JOHN DOESN'T STATE WHAT WAS SET AT THE N1/4 CORNER.

THIS CORNER FALLS ON THE CENTERLINE OF AN EAST-WEST GRAVEL ROAD AT THE INTERSECTION WITH A FENCE LINE NORTH AND OCCUPATION LINE RUNNING SOUTH.

ON AUG. 10, 2010 E.G. RUD AND SONS, INC. MADE AN EXCAVATION WITH THE COUNTY BACKHOE AT THIS LOCATION. AT 2-1/2 FEET BELOW THE SURFACE A RECTANGULAR ROCK 5" THICK, 12" WIDE AND 2 FEET LONG WAS FOUND. THIS TAPERED TO THE TOP AND A "4" WAS CHISELED ON TOP. THIS STONE WAS LAYING DOWN BUT WAS IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE FENCE LINE AND ON THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD. THE ROCK WAS PLACED UPRIGHT AGAIN AND A #7 REBAR WITH AN ALUMINUM CAP WAS SET FOR THE CORNER LOCATION, TIES WERE TAKEN AND KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES WERE ESTABLISHED ON THIS POSITION.
