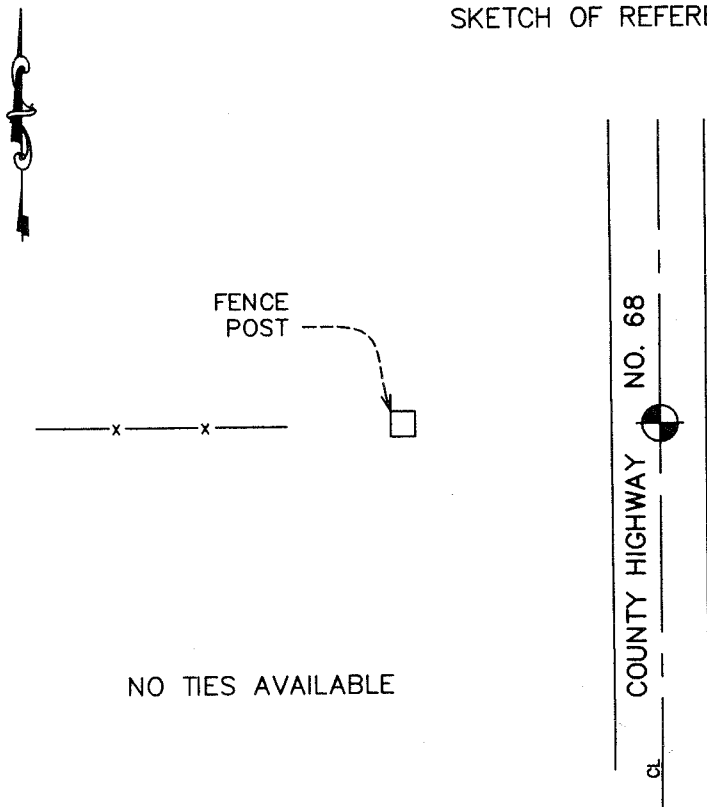

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE
(FROM TIE SHEET 735)

All of the original government bearing trees are now gone.

There is no resurvey data on file for this corner. There is a town road order on file dates 1903, that establishes a town road from the northwest corner of Section 6, Township 40, Range 22, south on the town line to the southwest corner of Section 30, Township 40, Range 22.

In January of 1986, I ran a survey along the west line of Township 40, Range 22, to locate existing monuments, lines of occupation and to search the area.

This corner falls at the intersection of road north-south and a fence line west.

In July of 1986, we made an excavation with a backhoe at this location. The excavation was 15 square feet, 3 feet deep centered on the center line of road and fence line. No evidence was found in the excavation.

I accepted the center line of the road and fence per the town road order west extended east as the best available evidence of the original corner location and set a 7/8" capped rebar to mark this corner.
