

Road order on file dated April 28, 1900. Thomas B Vickerey surveyed road on March 10, 1900 but doesn't state if any corners were set. Vickerey show distance to be 5280 feet or 80 chains. Today we measure 5280.33

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

THE ORIGINAL CORNER WAS SET IN OCTOBER 1851 BY GOVERNMENT SURVEYOR JOHN GIAY.

ANY EVIDENCE TO THE ORIGINAL CORNER AND BEARING TREES NO LONGER REMAIN.

IN 2003 WE DID A SURVEY AROUND SECTION 24 TO TIE IN EXISTING MONUMENTATION AND LINES OF OCCUPATION.

IN 2004 WE EXCAVATED A 12' BY 20' HOLE 1 1/2 FEET INTO NATURAL GROUND ON CENTERLINE OF GRAVEL ROAD AND ON OLD FENCELINE GOING NORTH. WE FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF ANY CORNER.

IN 2005 WE SET A MONUMENT AT THIS POSITION AND ESTABLISHED KANABEC COUNTY COORDINATES USING G.P.S. EQUIPMENT. This falls 8' west of a line & split.
