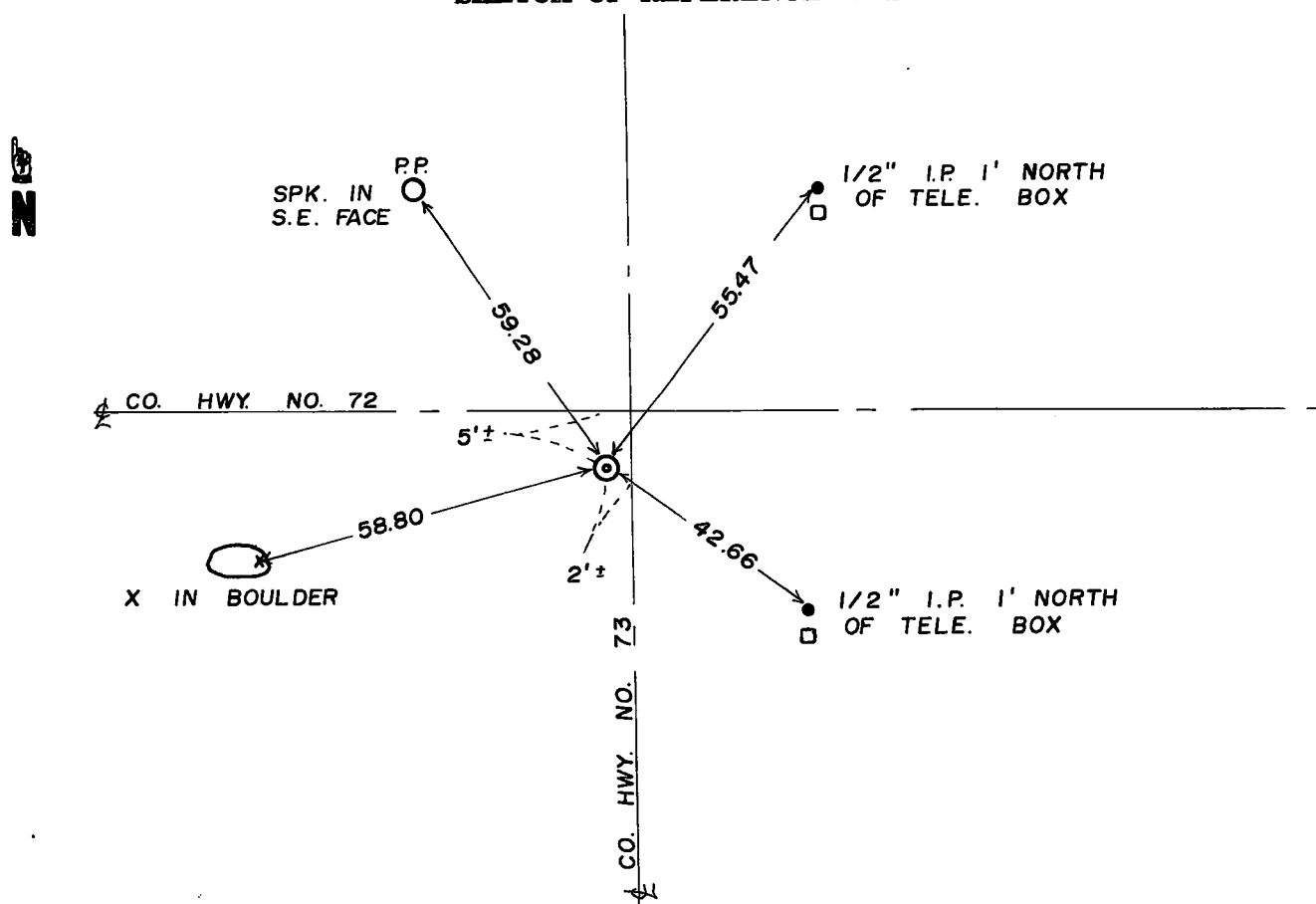

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

All of the original bearing trees are now gone.

In 1929, Charles Handschu, a Land Surveyor, found a sandstone marked with an "+" that was broken and drove a 2" iron pipe into the center of the broken sandstone.

In 1936, a Certificate of Government Corner was filed for this corner which shows an iron pin - Certificate No. 151.

This corner is at the intersection of roads north-south-east and west.

On September 24, 1982, we made an excavation with the County backhoe and at 1.5 feet below the surface we found a 2" iron pipe per Handschu's record. We lowered the 2" iron pipe and set a 4" by 17" cast iron monument on top of the 2" iron pipe.
