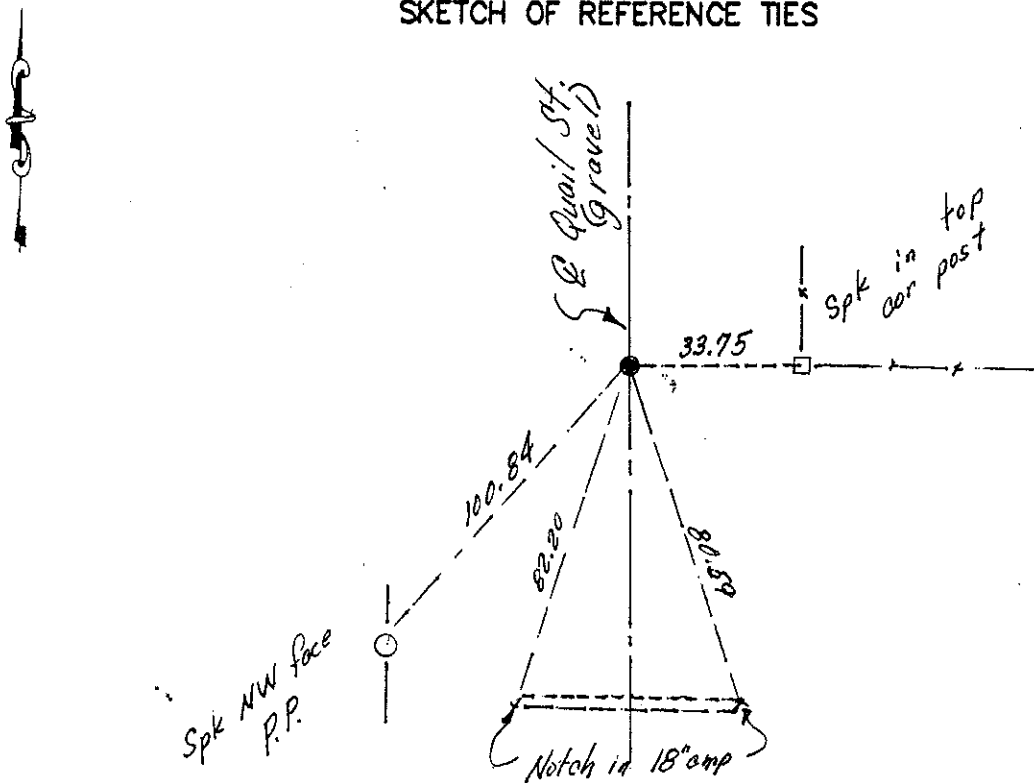

The original Government post was set by Deputy Surveyor John M Gley in September 1851 and 2 bearing trees were noted as:

5" Tamarack bearing South 35° West at 10 links

4" Tamarack bearing North 50° East at 11 links

No visible evidence remains today for the post or its accessories.

This corner falls in the centerline of Quail Street running north to south and an old fence running to the east. At this location we found a ½" iron pipe that fit within 1 ½ feet from a split between northeast and southeast corners of section 15. We accepted this monument to be the best evidence for the perpetuation of this corner. Ties were taken and Kanabec County coordinates established on this position.
