

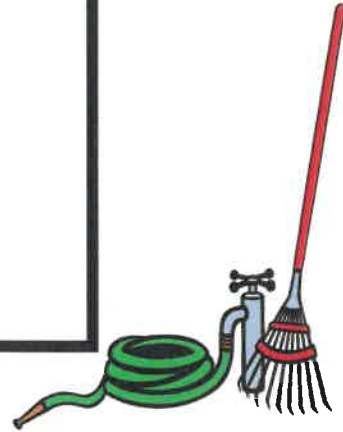
CITY OF KEWANEE LANDSCAPE WASTE PROGRAM

DOs

These items can be put into landscape waste bags:



Grass & weed clippings
Flowers
Garden vegetables and fruits
Tomato vines & bean vines
Leaves & small twigs
Corn husks and corn cobs
Sod/dirt
Walnuts & acorns



DON'Ts

These items cannot be put in landscape waste bags:

Landscape fabric and timbers
Plastic material/bags
Rocks, wire & any metal items
Bottles & cans of any kind
Paper & cardboard
Dead animals & animal waste

Bags must weigh less than 50 pounds.

- Landscape waste bag collection uses generic, biodegradable Kraft paper bags intended to be used for landscape waste. Users may purchase bags at a retailer of their choice. A \$1.00 City of Kewanee Excess Bag sticker must be affixed to each bag to be collected by the City. Stickers are available at City Hall, Beck's on 2nd and Tenney Streets, Farm King, JoJo's, CVS, Shell, Sullivan Foods, Casey's, and Walmart.
- Bags are picked up on Mondays only between the **3rd Monday in March and the 1st Monday in December**. If a holiday falls during the week, landscape waste will not be picked up that week. Bags should be set out on Sunday night and you can place an unlimited amount of bags at the curb as long as they have stickers applied.
- Small limbs and sticks placed in landscape bags cannot be longer than 1.5 feet, or larger than 1.5 inches in diameter.
