Your pipes are at risk of freezing during the winter months. Freeze damage isn't only confined to your pipes, your sewer lines are also susceptible to freezing. When it does occur, the pipes can burst or can close down a drain system. Proper insulation is essential to avoid such inconveniences.

Insulate pipes that will be exposed in freezing temperatures. Pay special attention to those that are located in outdoor areas. Instead of polythene foam insulation, use standard fiberglass wall insulation. This will provide more protection when insulating PVC sewer pipes.
