Environmental Health Policy Regarding Community Requests for Well and Septic Records

In an effort to respond to time-sensitive community requests, utilize clerical staff time as efficiently as possible and prioritize emergency and critical program work, the environmental health division must set policy regarding requests for records. We understand the public needs to be able to access our records for many different reasons, but staff are unable to meet the on-demand telephone and front counter requests.

Beginning May 6, 2014, we ask that septic and well record requests from realtors, home inspectors, appraisers, contractors, home owners, potential buyers and sellers be submitted in writing, preferable on this form to capture all of the information needed to research environmental health records. It may take up to 5 working days to respond to a request when clerical workload is heavy. We can no longer accept telephone inquiries. Emergency situations that arise will be dealt with on a case by case basis.

Copy fees as noted in the Environmental Health fee schedule apply, and are noted at the bottom of the form. Beginning October 1, 2014 a records search fee of \$6.00 will be collected with the records request.
