Minutes Wednesday, May 1, 2019

Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Lincoln County Commission held at 8:30 AM on May 1, 2019 in the County Commission Chambers, Lincoln County Courthouse, in Carrizozo, New Mexico.

1. Call to Order

Chair Stone called the Special Meeting of the Board of County Commissioners to order at 8:30 AM.

2. Roll Call

Roll Call.

3. Invocation

The invocation was presented by Chair Stone.

5. Approval of Agenda

Chair Stone recessed the Regular Meeting and convened the Public Hearing to consider the Preliminary Budget at 8:32 AM.

6. Public Hearing: Preliminary Budget Hearing, Fiscal Year 2019-2020

A) County Manager's Overview

Ms. Taylor provided a timeline for budget preparation noting the final deadline for submission of Lincoln County's budget to the Department of Finance and Administration was July 31, 2019. Ms. Taylor stated special funding challenges existed this year due to the County's construction of the replacement hospital. Ms. Taylor stated challenges included higher than anticipated construction costs coupled with pledged non-county funding sources not materializing.

Ms. Taylor stated the budget as presented reflected a revenue base of \$5,760,775 over the required reserve of \$2,134,511. Ms. Taylor stated by law the required reserve was equal to 3/12 of the General Fund Expenditures of \$8,538,045. Ms. Taylor stated the revenue base of \$5.76

million over the required reserve was at that level because neither the funding requests from External Agencies nor the Optional County requests were entered into this budget.

Ms. Taylor informed DFA's guidelines of expenses and transfers out of the General Fund to other funds are to be within 5% of the current year budgeted General Fund revenues. Ms. Taylor stated the current budget "what if" illustrated a healthy ratio of 8.73%. Ms. Taylor informed the formula does not take into account prior years' cash balances.

Ms. Taylor stated projected expenses were for the most part annualized and as such they were unconstrained. Ms. Taylor informed the current budget reflected a transfer of \$5,057,261 from the General Fund to cover departmental expenses including transfers of \$3,040,611 for Detention Center Operations; \$1,870,990 to supplement the Road Department Fund; and \$344,882 to supplement Senior Services Operations.

Ms. Taylor reminded the Department of Finance and Administration mandated the use of property tax valuations for 2017 for the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget. Ms. Taylor noted a growth rate increase of 5.16% in property tax valuation over last year. Ms. Taylor also noted the Payment in Lieu of Taxes received in June of 2018 was \$1,889,698 which was an increase of 8.7% over the 2017 PILT payment of \$1,738,123. Ms. Taylor stated the PILT revenue for 2018-2019 was based on a conservative forecast and estimated as \$1,726,851.

Ms. Taylor stated the utmost priority for the County Commission and the public this year was the costs tied to the remaining construction of the new replacement hospital including the following abatement and demolition of the existing hospital. Ms. Taylor anticipated the work to be completed by the end of 2019-2020.

Beverly Calaway, Treasurer stated her review of the preliminary Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget indicated a conservative representation of projected revenues and transfers. Ms. Calaway stated as presented the funding for this budget would reflect \$5,760,775 over the initial required reserve balances using the estimated beginning cash balance \$7,150,000.

Chair Stone recessed the Public Hearing and reconvened the Public Hearing at 10:20 AM.

C) Medical Related Budget/LCMC/Clinics

Todd Oberheau, Chief Executive reviewed the Lincoln County Medical Center (LCMC) budget requests for the hospital and the clinics in Capitan, Carrizozo, Corona, and Hondo. Mr. Oberheau stated in addition, Presbyterian was requesting additional operational funding for the White Mountain Medical Clinic.

Ms. Taylor stated the funding request of \$2,824,548 for the hospital was greater than the forecasted Mill Levy funds for fiscal year 2019-2020. Ms. Taylor stated the fund's carryover from prior years is \$2.348 million and was available for use as a funding source.

Ms. Taylor stated the request of \$1,178,691 for the rural clinics exceeds the forecasted Mill Levy funds of \$738,288 by \$440,463 or 60%. Ms. Taylor stated funds carried over from previous years in the amount of \$655,000 were available for use as a funding source but the current request would expend 67% of the carryover.

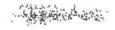
