Permit Application Certification:

I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared in accordance with all applicable Local, County, State and Federal laws. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment of knowing violations.

I certify that I have read and understand the ordinances of the Village of Machesney Park which relate to the proposed work and that I will comply with the provisions of said ordinances.

Further, I hereby agree that if I shall injure or alter, for any purpose whatsoever, any publicly owned property, I shall be responsible and liable to the Village for damages to persons or property in consequence thereof which the Village shall suffer or be adjudged to pay. Publicly owned property includes but is not limited to streets, alleys, pavement, sidewalk, curb, gutter, sanitary sewer systems, storm sewer systems, water systems, trees in the Right-of-Way, vegetated areas, parkways and any other structure owned by the Village.

Further, I agree to repair all damage to any street or public property that may arise due to operations by me, or my agents, and I further agree to hold the Village harmless against all claimants for any injuries to person or property occasioned by, or in any manner resulting from, my operations or public property. All work done within the right of way shall be subject to inspection and conformance with Village standards.

Further, The Village and/or any contractor doing work on behalf of the Village shall not be liable for any damage, alteration or removal of said improvements within the right of way in conjunction to or part of the normal scope of maintenance work or construction of a Village project. Driveways that project into the roadway may be subject to alteration or be encroached upon for

proper completion of street projects which may require work to be performed 6-24 inches beyond the road edge. The Village and/or its contractor shall reserve the right to perform this work within the normal range of that scope to complete the project.

I certify that my operations relating to this permit will not pose a significant risk to the general public and that all necessary safety measures will be taken to ensure the proper completion of the project.

Traffic control will be in accordance with all MUTCD standards. Trenches must be plated or covered during non-working hours on all through streets.
