City Manager Randy Fernandez thanked Polka Dot Panda and all who have made and contributed mask; we will have mask available to the public upon entering city hall; the golf course and boat launch are now open; we are following laws set by the State of Michigan and please obey social distancing laws.

Mayor Pyden mentioned a letter received from American Legion Post stating the Memorial Day parade is cancelled; if there are no further revisions or extension by the state, city operations will resume May 18th and a budget session scheduled at 5:30 p.m. with location to be determined.
