AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE MODOC SPECIAL TAX DISTRICT FOR FIRE PROTECTION PURSUANT TO SOUTH CAROLINA CODE SECTION 4-9-30(5)(E)

WHEREAS, the Modoc Special Tax District for Fire Protection was created by Ordinance 18-08 adopted August 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, a lawsuit has been filed against McCormick County contesting the establishment of the Modoc Special Tax District for Fire Protection; and

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code Section 4-9-30(5)e) provides that County Council may by ordinance abolish a special tax district; and

WHEREAS, McCormick County Council finds that it is in the best interest of the County to abolish the Modoc Special Tax District for Fire Protection, have the lawsuit dismissed with prejudice, and investigate the funding of fire protection throughout the County - including the potential establishment of a Countywide system of fire protection.


. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Council of McCormick County, South Carolina, that the Modoc Special Tax District for Fire Protection is hereby abolished pursuant to South Carolina Code Section 4-9-30(5)(e)

This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption after three (3) readings and any required public hearing.
