AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 22-01 AND THE MCCORMICK COUNTY BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR (FY) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2023.

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2022 Ordinance 22-01 was adopted approving the FY 22-23 Budget for McCormick County; and

WHEREAS, McCormick County Council has determined that Ordinance 22-01 and the McCormick County Budget for FY 2022-2023 should be amended to provide for increased revenue of \$978,152.21 and increased expenditures of \$978,152.21.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the County Council of McCormick County, in meeting duly assembled, that Ordinance 22-01 and the McCormick County Budget are amended to increase revenue and expenditures for FY 2022-2023 as set out herein.

Section 1: Revenue is increased by \$978,152.21 to be transferred from the general fund reserve account.

Section 2: Expenditure are increased as follows:

- a) \$742,588.21 – Implementation of the adopted wage and salary plan.
- b) \$64,064.00 – Contribution to the McCormick County Senior Center to assist in providing transportation services through the McCormick Area Transit (MAT).
- c) \$98,000.00 – Courthouse repairs and renovations.
- d) \$73,500.00 – Lighting for the new EMS facility.

Total Additional Expenditures - \$978,152.21

Section 3: The adjusted total revenues and total expenditures for FY 2022-2023 are:

TOTAL REVENUES: \$12,849,257.21

TOTAL EXPENDITURES: \$12,849,257.21

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption after three (3) readings and any required public hearing.
