- 1. No stockpiling of manure for more than forty-eight (48) hours.
- 2. Incorporation must occur within twenty-four (24) hours after spreading.
- 3. Application of manure must be according to agronomic rates based on soil tests, NPK concentrations, crop requirements, and yield goals.
- 4. McLeod County setbacks for stockpiling and manure application must be observed.
- 5. Manure shall be applied to cropland in such a way to as to avoid discharge to waters of the State.
- 6. Records must be kept of manure application for three (3) years and made available to the County upon request.

FAILURE TO CONFORM WITH THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS, MN RULES CHAPTER 7020, AND THE MCLEOD COUNTY FEEDLOT MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE WILL RESULT IN REVOCATION OF THIS PERMIT AND RENDER THE APPLICANT SUBJECT TO ENFORCEMENT ACTION. REVOCATION OF THE PERMIT WILL PROCEED IN THE SAME MANNER AS STATED IN THE MCLEOD COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE.
