Definitions

Witness Corner: A witness corner "stands in" when the true corner cannot be monumented or occupied because of difficult terrain or obstruction of the corner sight. The witness corner must be on the section line and is usually 5 or 10 chains away from the true corner.

Meander Corner: The intersection of a township, range, or section line and the banks of a navigable stream or meandering body of water.



This corner was originally established by the Government in May, 1855. The corner fell in a marsh and was monumented by a wood stake in a mound. Now there is a Township Road over this corner.

The only resurvey information we could find relative to this corner are some 1942 field notes by the County Highway Engineer. These notes show distances to the northeast and the southeast corners of Section 27, but don't show what was found or set at the quarter corner.

On July 7, 1978, we excavated for this corner at the location shown on county engineer field notes. (John Tupa from Hutchinson with a backhoe) We dug a hole approximately 15 feet long, 6 feet wide and 4 feet along the center line of the road. We found a very rotted wood stake down 4 feet below the surface. This stake was so rotted we could not pick it up, but it seemed to have a sharp point at the bottom. We took reference ties to the stake.

We measured north to the northeast corner of Section 27 and had a distance of 2617.80 feet compared with a distance of 2622.2 feet in 1942. Our distance to the southeast corner of Section 27 was 2659.59 feet compared with a distance of 2664 feet in 1942. (both distances 4.4 feet shorter than in 1942.)

We checked the east-west quarter lines of Sections 26 and 27 and found that in order to hit the fence corner near the center of Section 26 the quarter corner would need to move 17 feet south and in order to hit a field division near the center of Section 27 we would need to move the quarter corner 25 feet north. We found that a fence line running west at $\frac{1}{4}$ mile north is 29 feet south of the 1/16 line.

We do not know if the found stake was the original Government corner but we will accept it as the correct corner.

On NOvember 8, 1984, we set a McLeod County cast iron monument at the location of the stake and took additional reference ties.

January, 1995. The monument set by Knutson is accepted as marking the location of the government corner. It fits long standing occupation lines and it perpetuates the location of an older monument which was possibly the original government corner.

April 28, 1995. We checked the reference ties.

1855. John Ryan of the General Land Office originally established this corner. He set a post in a marsh, deposited charcoal, dug pits and trench, built mound and planted osage orange seeds at the corners of the mound.

1973. Harvey Boettcher, 44 years old and had lived in the Northwest Quarter of Section 1 all his life, said fence running south is about 30 years old and has been accepted as being on the north-south quarter line of Section 1. Clarence Kuehl, 43 years old and had lived in the Southwest Quarter of Section 36 all his life, said the intersection of the road center lines should be the corner.

March 26, 1973. Dickman Knutson, county surveyor, excavated for the corner. (John Tupa from Hutchinson with a backhoe) They found a 2 inch by 2 inch by 14 inch wood hub at the center line intersection of roads east-west-north and in line with a fence to the south. They took reference ties and dug more but found no other evidence of the government corner.

September 20, 1973. Knutson set a McLeod County cast iron monument and took additional ties.

April 10, 1995. We found the monument in good condition down 12 inches below the surface and took new reference ties.

February 12, 1973. Walt Mueffelmann, 51 years old and lived in the Northwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 113, Range 28 all his life, said his father told him there was a stone, flat on top, marking the corner and was supposed to be close to the center line intersection of the roads. He said the east-west road was rebuilt 8 years ago and the north-south road was rebuilt 12 years ago.

1973. Delbert Rieke, Sibley County Surveyor, found a 4 inch square stone with a lath along side, 3 feet below the surface of the road. This was near the center line intersection of roads north, south, east and west. A stone was recorded at the corner by A. Lehman, Slbley County Engineer in 1933. Rieke set a cast iron monument at the corner.

March 27, 1995. We found the monument in good condition down 12 inches below the surface of the gravel road and took new reference ties.
