Preservation Project Begins June 20 on Various County Roads

June 14, 2016

A pavement preservation project will begin Monday on approximately 30 miles of McLeod County roads. The project is a combination of seal coating and fog sealing. The project should take around 10 days. Scott Construction of Lake Delton, WI was awarded this year's seal coat project. Value of the work is approximately \$525,000.

The locations are shown on the attached map.

The roads will remain open. Flaggers will be present to help guide traffic; which should expect minor delays.

Seal coating is a preventative maintenance activity that involves applying liquid emulsified asphalt to a blacktop surfaced road and covering with aggregate chips. This process extends the life of the roadway and helps hold off costly reconstruction. Fog sealing involves spraying the road with a liquid emulsion.

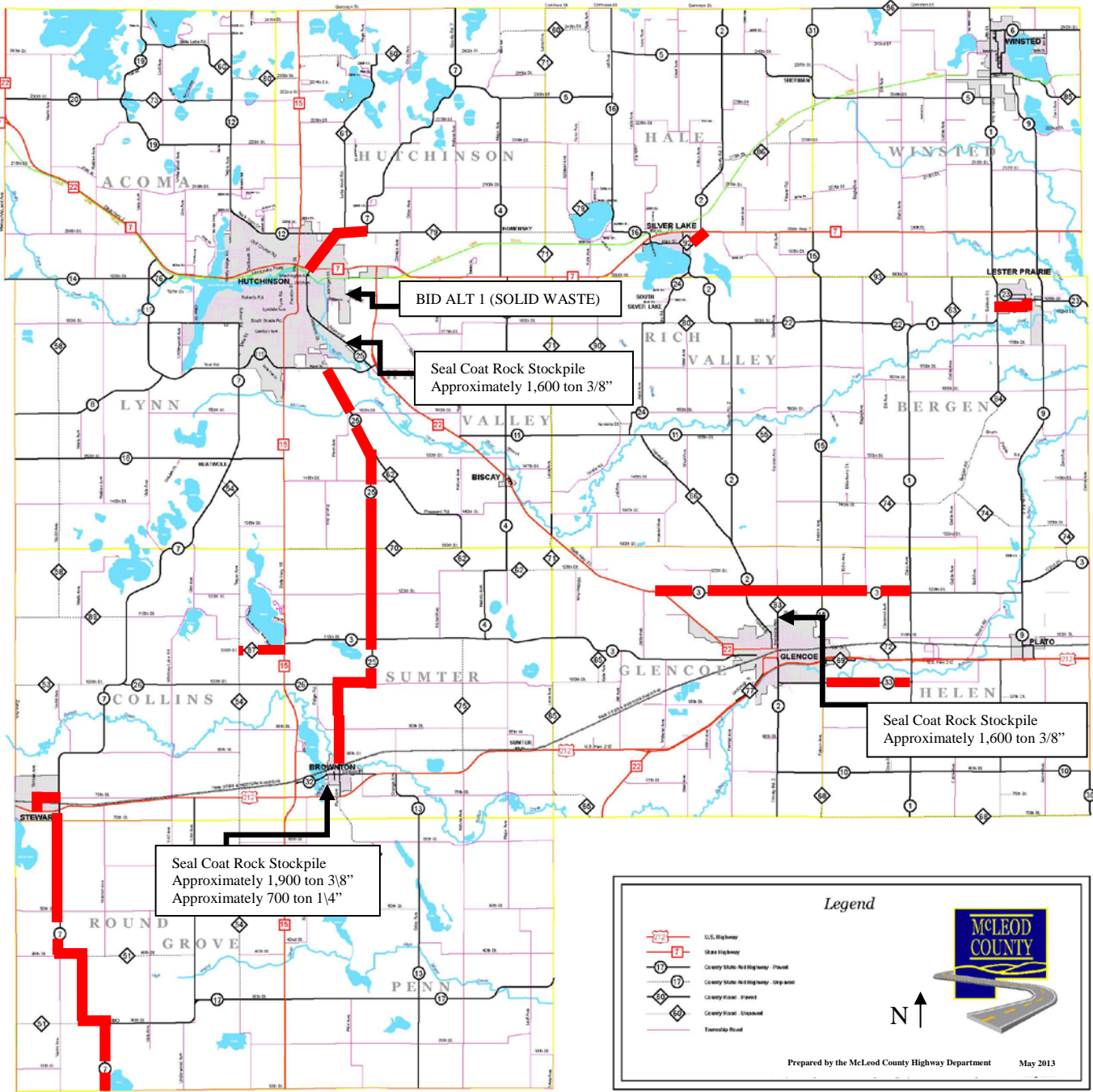
