County Road 54 (Tagus Avenue) Cement Stabilization/Chip Seal Construction Project Begins August 22

August 16, 2018

A road construction project on County Road 54 (Tagus Avenue) between Sunset Circle and County Road 7 is scheduled to begin August 22, 2018.

Allstates Pavement Recycling & Stabilization of Rogers, MN was awarded the \$414,000 County funded project.

The project includes blending cement powder and water with portions of the existing gravel surface and subgrade material to create a hardened base layer. Once the base is stabilized with cement, the road will then be covered with a chip seal similar to what is applied on paved asphalt roads. The purpose of the chip seal is to protect the stabilized base from weather and to act as a wear surface.

The road will be closed to thru traffic; there will be no posted detours in place. Motorists are advised to use Trunk Highway 15 as an alternative route.

The project should last approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting.
