

PARK SEASON & HOURS

Season: Runs approximately May 1st to October 1st

Hours: 8:00am to Sunset

CAMPING FEES:

Electric Site: \$30.00/day

Non-Electric Site: \$23.00/day

Extra tent on any site: \$23.00/day (3 units maximum/site)

Dump Station: free for paid campers; all other \$10.00

Check in time is 4 pm or after

Check out time is by 2pm

PICNIC SHELTER RESERVATION:

Shelter Reservation Fee: \$35/day

Reservations can be made by calling the parks office after January 1st @ 320-484-4301

RESERVATION POLICY:

If the reservation is cancelled 14 days or more prior to the arrival date, a \$10 administration fee per site will be forfeited.

If the reservation is cancelled fewer than 14 days prior to the arrival date, the first nights camping fee plus a \$10 administration fee per site will be forfeited.

The refund will be issued back in a check. Please allow 2-3 weeks for processing.

- Park visitors must leave at 10 PM
- Quiet time begins at 10:30pm; Any type of disturbances, you will be asked to leave the park.
- Park boats, trailers and extra vehicles in designated parking lots.

ORDINANCES - IT IS UNLAWFUL TO:

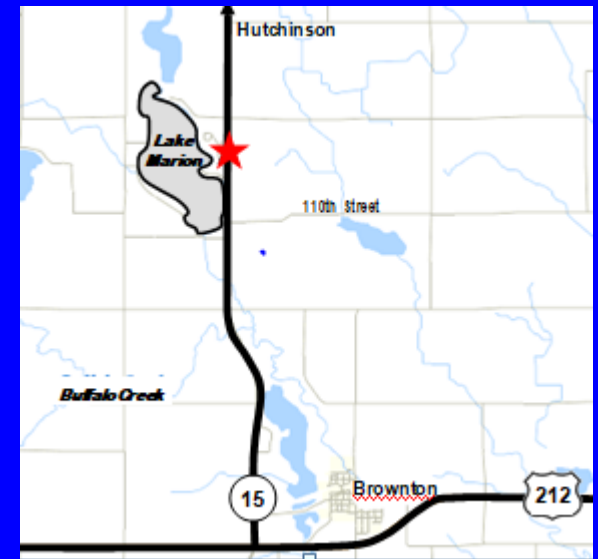
- Light/Use fireworks in the park.
- Bring pets into the park unless caged or kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet (don't tie leashes to trees or electrical boxes)
- Kill, trap, hunt or disturb in any manner any species of wildlife.
- Start a fire in the park except in the designated grills or fire pits.
- Cut live trees for any reason.
- Loud noises will not be permitted at any time. On the second warning, you will be evicted.
