1. As co-grantees MHA and the City of Memphis preserved and created 712 units of affordable housing via the Choice Neighborhood Implementation grant.
2. Using the City's Down payment Assistance Program both Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher participants can become homeowners through MHA's Family Self-Sufficiency Programs.
3. MHA is an active partner to reduce homelessness.
4. Using minority vendors, MHA assists with City's goal of economic development within Memphis and Shelby County.
5. MHA provides housing opportunities for people with extremely low, low, and moderate incomes and assists with the goal of the City of Memphis to provide New Affordable and preserve existing affordable housing. The Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) is but one of the tools to be used by MHA that will result in neighborhood stabilization.
