to Historic Manitowoc and Brillion!

Explore Manitowoc and Brillion. All guided tours, including the Hamilton Print, Rahr-West Museum and AriensCo Museum!



- **The Hamilton Wood Type and Printing Museum** showcases over 100 years of American printing history. The museum houses the largest collection of wood-type blocks and printing equipment, and is the only museum dedicated to the preservation, study, production and printing of wood type. A tour guide will take you through the various wood types and equipment in the museum. A beautiful gift shop featuring museum posters, wood crafts, and much more is available. This is a must-see museum!
- **Lunch on your own at Beerntsen's Confectionary** featuring a variety of sandwiches and the famous Beerntsen's Candies and ice cream. Joseph Beerntsen's dream of owning Beerntsen's Candies came to life (with the Bernstein family backing) in Green Bay, Chicago and Milwaukee, and then in Manitowoc in 1930. Joseph owned the business until 1958. In 2003, Dean and Chrissy, began carrying on the Beerntsen's traditions.
- **The Rahr-West Museum** features 13 rooms housing an extensive art collection throughout the museum. On September 5, 1962, a 20-pound piece of the Russian Sputnik fell directly in front of the museum. A cast of the Sputnik piece is on display! Reinhart Rahr purchased a house built for Joseph and Mary Vilas (1891/1893) in 1910 and in 1941, his widow donated the house to the city of Manitowoc, now the Rahr-West Museum.
- **The AriensCo Museum** tells the story of our country's journey from the horse and ploy to horsepower featuring interactive exhibits with vintage equipment and unique memorabilia. A tour guide will take you through the 10 galleries and 120 years of the Ariens Company history. And, there's a gift store featuring one-of-a-kind souvenirs and gifts.
- **Moderate amount of walking.**
