### **DWSRF (Drinking Water State Revolving Fund)**

Applications for 2022 are due later this month. I have asked the Dufresne Group to prepare an application for a Water Tank addition and a new well siting near Well #2.

### **CWSRF (Clean Water State Revolving Fund)**

The State staff has completed a first draft review of the engineering agreement with Tata and Howard and has sent comments back to T&H; they will address.

### **Library Historic Window Project**

Dana Hart has submitted a 2022 Historic Preservation Grant application and we recently received notice of a grant award. She is preparing bid documents and this will be put out to bid in the coming weeks. The project covers the historic windows and doors on the Main Street face of the building.

### **Tree Inventory**

The tree inventory completed in 2016 has been uploaded into our MapInfo GIS program. The trees are located on the town-wide map. Hans Raum and I have been working together to mine the data and get a working database going. The committee will now be able to update the inventory.

### **Swanage Court Storm Sewer Project**

Swanage Court Storm Sewer is a storm sewer replacement between Swanage Court and Harrow Way in the Buttolph Subdivision. The existing pipe clogs with tree roots and a couple structures are undersized. Landmark Engineering has submitted a proposal for design and

construction services at \$24,750. We have funds reserved to begin the engineering process. I request the Committee send the proposal to the Select Board for approval.

### **Colonial Drive – Project Engineer update**

Alan Huizenga, President of Green Mountain Engineering has notified us that he will be closing down his business as of February 18<sup>th</sup>. I am in the process of arranging for engineering services with other firm(s).

### **Triangle Bike Loop**
