


Three Middlebury College students complete a research project that identifies a potential cycling route connecting Middlebury, Vergennes, and Bristol.


The SE Group gathers input from various stakeholders and completes the Triangle Loop Master Plan.


The Walk-Bike Council of Addison Country and the Addison Country Regional Planning Commission finalize the route.




Triangle Loop




The Route in Middlebury

Benefit 1
