Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) – Priority List Applications

Applications to the DWSRF Program have been submitted. They are: Water Tank Addition on Chipman Hill, New well site near well #2, and Foote Street Water Main replacement (last southern section).

Clean Water State Revolving Fund Application (CWSRF) – Priority List Applications

Applications were submitted for: Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade and for South Street Reconstruction – Phase II (sanitary main replacement).

Middlebury Rail Sidewalk

VHB has submitted a proposal to design and permitting services for a sidewalk from the new rail platform into the downtown. The route is anticipated to be in the State's Rail ROW and then along the eastern boundary of the Marble Works.

The Town has been awarded a \$100,000 Downtown Transportation Fund Grant for this project. It is a 50/50 grant. The Town will need to request a grant amendment to the State because this location is different from the original submission. The amendment request has received a positive “head nod” and paperwork to follow.

Court Street- Charles-Monroe Intersection

VHB has submitted a proposal for Preliminary Design of the Court Street/Charles/Monroe Intersection. They have described eight (8) specific tasks in the proposal. The goal is to have a Presentation Plan completed in August of this year. We have funds reserved to cover the cost of their services.
