1. Meeting objectives

2. US Route 7

A. Bike Walk Council have suggested Bulbs outs at crosswalk near Creek Rd.

- It was decided that RRFB would be the appropriate solution for this location. D&K will incorporate into the final plans.

B. Review need for School Crossing signs @ (Sta. 228+54 & 240+48)

- It was decided that these signs do not meet the warrants due to the signal and not being directly adjacent to the school, signs will be removed and salvaged to the town. D&K will incorporate into the final plans.

C. Discuss curb line over drainage structure south of Court Square

- D&K will look into adjusting the radius of the drives/side roads to allow the drainage grate to be moved over the basin on the northbound side of the road, the town will look at addressing the southbound side with the waterline project.

D. Confirm Pavement type (Bit. or Conc.) at bottom of Court Square

- Material is Synthetic Asphalt Compound not Concrete.

E. Discuss requested crossing near Seminary St.

- The Sight distance at this intersection is poor, the crossing would result in loss of parking and would be skewed. Appeared grades will not allow compliant ramps without work outside the ROW. There are other crossings within reasonable distance. It was decided that it would be best to not add a crossing.

F. Discuss shoulder widths at north end of project (North of Maplefields)

- D&K will evaluate if slopes will allow widening the northbound side to get a consistent 3' width along through this section, and will add ditching and shoulder reconstruction in the area if feasible.

3. VT Route 30

G. Discuss Flashing beacons on Ped Crossing signs (Sta. 35+54)

- It was agreed that this would be a good location for a RRFB, Dan will inform the college.

H. Discuss Shared Lane Marking along East Academy Street

- Shared lane markings will be incorporated into the drawings on the approaches to the roundabout and on Academy lane.

4. VT Route 125

I. Discuss Flashing beacons on Ped Crossing Ahead (Sta. 16+44)

- This is going to be moved by the town prior to the project.

J. Discuss curb relocation/widening (Sta. 17+00 – Sta. 20+00 +/- RT)

- Curb will remain as will the centerline.

K. Discuss modified bulb out near Weybridge St. (Sta. 100+50)

- No, a modified sharrow will be added to encourage cyclists to turn, the do not enter sign here will be considered for upsizing.

L. Review ped button @ VT 125/VT 30 intersection

- A little bit of conc will be added to fillet the corner between the sidewalk and ramp on the northbound side of RT 30 to allow closer access to the push button.

M. Discuss use of BMUFL signs and Shared Lane Marking near roundabout

- The Share the Road signs and bicycle warning signs will be removed. The BMUFL signs will stay. Sharows will be added to the roundabout entrances.
