Water System Upgrades

A spreadsheet is attached summarizing the near-term water main upgrade projects with associated costs and funds needed. We will discuss the timing of construction and funding needs.

Highway Projects

Sidewalk Projects

The proposed Sidewalk Capital budget is \$91,300. Attached are maps of four (4) areas to be considered that would fit within the budget.

VTrans Class 1 Paving

Bill Kernan and I met with VTrans' Project Managers, Traffic Signal Coordinator, and their design consultant DuBois & King about the signal equipment needs for this project. The controllers inside the cabinets need

to be upgraded and more radar detection units will be added at intersections. It sounds like VTrans will pick up these costs.

The imprinted crosswalk material will be not be replaced in-kind. Crosswalks will be white-blocked instead.

The Project is expected to begin in the spring of 2021.

Public Works Building initiative

Bill and I are meeting with Judy Harris next week to revive the Public Works Building & Site project.

Maple Street Storm Sewer

Brent Rakowski (OCE) and I have met with the three property owners along Maple Street and Willard Street and reviewed the project concept with them. We will need permanent easements from all three owners to build and maintain the storm sewer. They are in agreement with the need for them.

Brent will update the design plans and then I will get this info to Benj Putnam to draft easement agreements.

We are still planning for this work and the rail platform parking area to be done in the spring of 2021.
