

MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT
EAST MIDDLEBURY FLOOD RESILIENCY PROJECT
REQUIRED COMPONENT OF GRANT APPLICATION TO FEMA

The Town of Middlebury, State of Vermont, hereby agrees that if it receives any Federal aid as a result of the said project application, East Middlebury Flood Resiliency Project, Village of East Middlebury, VT (*address*) it will accept responsibility, at its own expense if necessary, for the **routine** maintenance of any real property, structures, or facilities acquired or constructed as a result of such Federal aid. Routine maintenance shall include, but not be limited to, such responsibilities as keeping vacant land clear of debris, garbage, and vermin; keeping stream channels, culverts, and storm drains clear of obstructions and debris; and keeping detention ponds free of debris, trees, and woody growth.

The purpose of this agreement is to make clear the Subgrantee's maintenance responsibilities following project award and to show the Subgrantee's acceptance of these responsibilities. It does not replace, supersede, or add to any other maintenance responsibilities imposed by Federal law or regulation and which are in force on the date of project award.
