Dear Infrastructure Committee and Selectboard Board Members,

At its most recent meeting on March 31<sup>st</sup>, The Middlebury Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee voted unanimously to support the purchase of an AquaClimb Climbing wall for the Middlebury Town Pool at a cost of \$26,423.00. Committee members are in agreement that the new feature will become the cornerstone of the revitalized Middlebury Recreation Park. The new climbing wall will be emblazoned with the Middlebury Parks and Recreation logo and at a height of 13ft will draw attention to the pool from anywhere in the Recreation Park. With new attention on the pool we fully expect that the new amenity will increase daily admissions as well as seasonal passes and therefore lead to higher revenues. This new project aligns with the department and committees' goal of increasing usership in the Recreation Park and making it a true destination spot for families to come and spend the day. Committee Members have by unanimous vote agreed to permit Committee Board Chair, Greg Boglioli, to sign on behalf of the Parks and Recreation Committee Members.
