At its meeting on Thursday, June 22, 2017, the Town of Middlebury Infrastructure Committee will discuss the newly-issued Creek Road Erosion Stability Report. The study was commissioned by the Addison County Regional Planning Commission on behalf of the Town of Middlebury after a portion of Creek Road was closed to vehicular traffic in the spring of 2015 due to safety concerns. The goal of the study was to assess the nature of flooding and bank erosion along Otter Creek; explore strategies for stabilizing the banks on Creek Road; identify lower-cost, sustainable alternatives for re-opening the road; and provide alternative designs with cost estimates.

The purpose of this meeting is to collect input on the study for consideration by the Infrastructure Committee and Selectboard as they consider the alternatives presented in the report.
