

Steps to making a safer street:

- Add a temporary crosswalk where the sidewalk ends to facilitate crossing to the protected pedestrian lane.
- Add temporary sharrow stencils to roadway so bikes know where to ride
- Create a 4-ft pedestrian lane (not actually painted) but striped with white marking tape. Add delineator posts approximately 6-8-ft apart for protection
- Paint corner at Willard/Maple to narrow turning radius
- Add a temporary crosswalk at Maple/Willard.
