Library Capital Improvements

Dana and I are working on Bid documents for the historic window restoration and replacement of a few non-historic windows; and one for painting exterior windows. We also have a proposal for the heating system upgrade design. These will be coming to the committee for consideration in March and/or April.

Cady Road Culvert – Pipe-Arch Purchase

The culvert structure for this project will be an aluminum structural plate pipe-arch. Basically it looks like a squashed egg. The span is 6' 7' wide, 5'8' high and length of ~ 50 feet. There are aluminum wingwalls at each end. This is the same type of structure we used at the Halpin Road culvert project a couple years ago.

Contech Engineered Solutions of Scarborough, Maine manufactures this culvert. We want to make sure the culvert is available at the time the contractor is to begin~ June 29th , so we need to place the order soon. A Contech crew will assemble the culvert at the site. This is the most efficient and cost effective means.

Contech has submitted a proposal to supply the culvert and to assemble it on-site.

Supply: \$33,488; Assembly: \$13,000. Total: \$46,488.

Request the Committee send the proposal to the Selectboard for approval.
