

**Special Statement Regarding Changes to
Middlebury Municipal Operations
Effective March 18, 2020**

In response to the ongoing threat to public health posed by the spread of the COVID-19 virus, **all Town of Middlebury buildings and facilities will be closed to the public beginning Wednesday, March 18th.** Buildings will remain closed until we receive notice from state and federal officials that it is safe to resume normal operations.
