Where Are We Now?

It's a rough estimate, but we can estimate that we currently have 1,580 active COVID cases in Vermont, from the east coast across the Greens to the west coast, and from Quebec to Mass. At least these are the known positive tests reported through today. And these are the infections we are aware of; it's very possible there are a lot more out there hiding in plain sight. That's many times more than we were aware of back in the halcyon days of summer.

More On Testing Registration

We'll assume now you've navigated the COVID test registration site and have created an account, so we'll take it step-by-step from there. I know, rudimentary for some, but we still get requests for assistance from the 'analog' generation. Here you go:

1. Go to healthvermont.gov
2. At the top of the screen in red font, click on "COVID 19 in Vermont"
3. The next screen has a menu on the left side. In that menu is "TESTING". Click on TESTING.
4. Next screen, scroll down a bit you'll see a box with "REGISTER FOR HEALTH DEPARTMENT TESTING." Click on this, even you you've already registered to get the account number.
5. Next screen, at the very top right, in the black border, click on "LOGIN".
6. Next you'll get a screen printed "Welcome Back". Below that enter your user name and password that you selected when you registered earlier. Click on "LOGIN" in the blue box below your user name and password.
7. You'll get a screen with a consent warning. To continue, click on the consent box box and then click on "NEXT" at the bottom of the screen.
8. You'll now get a screen entitled "Attendee Personal Information". Fill it out if it doesn't auto fill from your initial registration process. Then click on "SUBMIT" at the bottom of the screen.
9. On the next screen, go to the upper right and click on the blue box that says 'SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT'

10. The subsequent screen asks you the “SELECT A PERSON FOR TESTING”. It will then list you and any dependents you had registered earlier. Make a selection and click on SUBMIT

11. You’re getting close, it seems almost like a scavenger hunt, and it may be in an institutional sort of way. This screen is entitled “APPOINTMENT SCHEDULING”. Click on PICK A LOCATION and then click on NEXT.

12. A list of testing sites will come up. Scroll up and down till you find the site of your choice. Click on it, and a list of test dates will appear on the right side of the screen. You’re about done. Click on the date and then follow the prompts from there. Talk about a 12-step process!
