If The Weather Kept You From a Vaccine Appointment

Those who could not make it to their appointments or preferred to not travel in winter weather should call [855-722-7878](tel:855-722-7878) to re-schedule. You will be given a new appointment for the same time on a day later this week, if possible. If that day isn't convenient, you can ask for a new appointment on a later day. You will not have to begin the registration process all over again.

People who have registered to get their vaccine at Kinney Drugs should contact the store at which they made their appointment if they need to reschedule.

Registrations For The 75+ Age Band Have Slowed

About 34,000 Vermonters in the age 75+ age band have registered for the vaccination so far. There are another 15,000 who have yet to register.

Obtaining an Account For Testing or Getting a Vaccine

We're answering here a query from one who is preparing to register for a vaccine, but has never had an account number and has never registered for a test. They are probably not the only one. So here is the step-by-step:

You'll see these instructions:

1. Create an account.
2. Check your email to verify your account and get your Patient ID (check your spam folder if you don't see the email).
3. Log in with your Patient ID.
4. Register for a testing or vaccination event.

1. Complete the form at the right of the instructions to create your account with VDH. Enter your first name, last name, phone number, email address, email address again (to confirm); and your birth date, (all in numbers- Month/Day/Year).

2. In the box below the form, outlined in blue you'll see "CREATE ACCOUNT". Click in the box.

3. You will eventually receive an email with your account number and further instructions. It could take a day to get your credentials due to a heavy registration load, so be patient.

4. Once you have your account credentials (such as your account number and password), go right back to the original screen, using the same link as above. Although this time, don't fill in the form. Go up to the dark band at the top of the screen and click on "LOGIN" in the upper right. Follow the prompts from there. In the Bulletin last Monday (Jan 25), in Update #2, we listed the process step-by-step.

Increase Slated For Vaccine Allotment

The Johnson and Johnson vaccine is in the final stages for emergency approval. While not having the efficacy of Moderna or Pfizer vaccines, there have been no reports of anaphylaxis with any of the 44,000 people on whom the vaccine has been tested. In addition, the Governor reported that we shall soon see a 22% increase in the vaccine allotment to Vermont, up to close to 11,000 units per week.
