Costco Now Has Vaccines

20% of Vermonters have now been vaccinated. As things ramp up, Costco, like Walmart this week, has become another outlet for the Vermont Department of Health COVID vaccination program. CVS Pharmacies are expected to come on line soon as well, providing more options.

Possible Openings At The Spaulding High School Mass Vaccination Site

Kinney drugs has 1,100 doses of vaccine to be administered at the mass vaccination site at Spaulding High School for those age 65+. As of this morning, there were still vacant spots. Of course, this could be an example of the great philosopher Yogi Berra's profound observation: "Nobody goes there anymore because it's too crowded".

K-12 Educators and Child Care Providers Getting Ready to Go

Teachers and staff will not have to sign up for vaccines through the VDH system. School districts will be notified directly through AHS/VDH when the teachers in their schools will commence vaccinations. School districts in selected counties will begin first. These include districts in Bennington, Rutland, and some others, apparently due to recent higher rates of COVID in those counties. School districts in Addison County have NOT yet been selected. Notifications and scheduling will go directly through the districts.

Updates For the Homebound

If you are homebound and cannot leave the home, you may qualify for a home administered vaccine. There is a new number to call and register. That number is **833-722-0860**.
