VAX Open For 12-15 Year Olds

Breaking News: SEEKING WALK-INS- 12-15 yr olds - TODAY! Until 11:30 at the Legion Post. More vaccines than people registered. Hurry, hurry, step right up and get your shot! Spread the news!

Vaccination registration has opened to Vermonters ages 12 to 15 this morning, following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's action late Wednesday authorizing use of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine for this age group.

The Food & Drug Administration authorized this emergency use of the vaccine earlier this week. On Wednesday, the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices overwhelmingly recommended, and the CDC approved, this use of the vaccine, based on clinical trial data that found it to be safe and effective.

Parents and caregivers are encouraged to vaccinate these young Vermonters. It's safe, easy and effective. Appointments can be made by visiting healthvermont.gov/MyVaccine. You can create an account, or use your existing account, adding the child as a dependent. Those making appointments for this age group will only see clinics with the Pfizer vaccine. If you need assistance, you can call 855-722-7878. Parental/caregiver consent is required for vaccination of this age group. Consent can be given as part of the online registration process or at a clinic in person.

The Health Department is working in partnership with the Agency of Education to offer school-based clinics with daytime and evening hours. Potentially the others may eventually approved, but right now 12-15 years are only qualified for the Pfizer vaccine.
