**Do Pop-Up tests Screen for Antibodies?**

No, the pop-up testing being conducted around the state does NOT test for antibodies, This question has come up as of late. The samples taken are tested for the presence of Coronavirus. The test result will either be positive, in other words, YES you are infected with COVID-19, or negative, that is, at the time the sample was taken, the lab not detect the presence of COVID-19. If “YES” you will be referred to your health provider.

**Weekend Watch**

Since Friday, 2 new positive tests were reported in Addison County, the first in many weeks. See- it really is still out there. A total of 8 new positives came in statewide since Friday. The good thing is that no one right now is hospitalized confirmed with COVID-19 in the state. No one is in the ICU and no one on ventilators. The tests and monitoring have now exceeded 36,000, with 880 listed recoveries in the aggregate. It appears that at present there are about 50-60 people in Vermont known to have COVID-19. That’s more than zero, and the numbers, small as they are, are still growing in the southern counties bordering Massachusetts.
