By the Numbers

The Winooski outbreak, which skewed the aggregate numbers, appears to have peaked. Just one new statewide positive case of CV-19 on June 14. The aggregate since early March is now 1,128 positive cases in Vermont, of which less than 200 are still active (predominantly in the Winooski outbreak). There were no hospitalizations from the Winooski outbreak, 40% of those who tested positive were children, and the median age was 21.

About 54,000 people have now been tested or have completed monitoring. There haven't been any new CV-19 related deaths in over 2 weeks.
