POP-UP Testing

I know – we said we would not be putting out a bulletin today unless something came up – it did:

The June 26 pop-up testing in Middlebury is full. The local office of the Vermont Department of Health has added some more testing dates, on a limited attendance basis. You can register here:

June 30, July 10, July 17, July 24, July 31, and there will probably be weekly testing in August. Not all the dates may be open for registration yet, but June 30, July 10 and 17 are up. As sporadic clusters of CV-19 occur around the state, and with things opening up they are expected, Health Department staff are being deployed for testing and contact tracing, so that limits the availability of local pop-up capacity.

So if you've been considering it, sign up quick! The tests are being administered at 156 South Village, off of Court Street just south of Creek Rd, at the Health Department offices across the lot from People's Bank.

Another One for Addison County

A positive test was reported today in Addison County, the only positive test in the state since yesterday. Like a pesky salesman, the bug just wants to let us know it's still here among us.
