




2021 Construction Activities

Main Street, Merchants Row, and Water Street Final Paving


- Marble Works Restoration and Paving

- Project Cleanup and Completion!






2021 Construction Finishing Touches

- Final Surface Drainage Adjustments
- Pavement Markings and Signs
- Landscape Plantings

2021 Construction Activity Impacts

 Intermittent short-term lane closures on Main Street and Merchants Row to facilitate site grading, landscaping, and final paving

- Printer's Alley remains closed to vehicles for reconstruction (open to pedestrians)
- Triangle Park and Lazarus Park remain closed for landscaping
- Temporary sidewalk closures for sidewalk reconstruction

2021 Construction Activity Impacts

 Intermittent short-term impacts along Marble Works and Seymour Street for northern U-Wall cast-in-place concrete caps

- Southern U-Wall cast-in-place concrete cap replacement
 - Will include intervals of night work
 - Demolition to begin mid-May

2021 Passenger Railroad Platform Project

- The project involves construction of a new passenger rail platform between the railroad and Middle Seymour Street
- Construction will take place from April through September 2021
- The platform will become an Amtrak stop on the Ethan Allen Express with service between Burlington and New York City

2021 Middlebury Paving Project

- Currently under construction and to be completed in September 2021
- Town streets to be affected:
 - Vermont Route 30 (Main Street, South Main Street)
 - Vermont Route 125 (Cross Street, College Street, Academy Street)
 - US Route 7 (Court Street, Court Square)
