

Washington Street – Court Square Water Main Project

The Washington Street – Court Square Water Main Project gets underway in April.

The water main will be replaced from the intersection of Main Street and Seymour Street, over to the Green, across Court Square, then down Washington Street to Seminary Street.

The majority of the work through the entire project will be done at night, roughly 6pm to 6am. There will be traffic control and signage to help with traffic flow.

The contractor, Belden Construction will begin mobilization the first week of April. The first area of excavation will be at the intersection of Main Street and Seymour Street to install a new valve and valve vault. This will be done at night, tentatively on April 11.

We have been approved for a grant of \$750,000 from the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund **and** a grant of \$600,000 from the Northern Borders Regional Commission. Construction will begin in the spring. The project construction cost is \$1,986,895. Project completion is anticipated at September 30.
