

Middlebury State Airport- update, May 2018

The majority of the work on the runway 700' extension and safety zone tree cutting from last summer is complete. The runway now meets current FAA design standards. VTRANS, the pilots, and local businesses continue to value the airport being a vibrant part of the community.
