SUB: Comments on Single-Lane Options- Creek Road

I have reviewed the plans for single-lane sections on Creek Road.

1. There is generally ample site distance on this road to establish single lane sections. There should not be one-lane only sections where adequate site distance on approach from either end is restricted by the curvature of the road.
2. Approach from one direction (consistent along the road) should be posted with a "Yield" sign to control right-of-way.
3. Traffic load on this road, even when open, was light. I foresee minimal conflicts, even on the longer one-way sections (180', 220').

I have a concern over the potential of increased traffic load when considering the deterioration and undermining of the road bed by water impingement and erosion. I'll defer that analysis further to engineers.
