New ACTR Schedule

Middlebury, Vermont ... Addison County Transit Resources (ACTR) will publish a new Shuttle Bus System schedule on Tuesday, August 28, 2018. Highlights of the new schedule include:

- Expanded phone access to Dispatch staff until 6:00pm, Monday-Friday.
- Fare-free travel within defined areas of the Town of Bristol and the City of Vergennes on the Tri-Town Shuttles, 116 Commuter and Saturday LINK.
- New midday loop on the Tri-Town Vergennes shuttle.
- Adjustments to Middlebury Shuttle schedules to accommodate new Addison Central School District times and match rider usage.

Details of these changes and other schedule tweaks can be found at actr-vt.org. The August 28 schedule launch will also be supported by new schedule signage at all bus stops, new schedule brochures, and updated trip planner tools.
