> Natel has remained either unwilling or unable to provide any level of detail required regarding their proposal. They have also refused or been on able to provide accounting for the cost of the project and why it would be so expensive.

> We were required, and complied with, and 80% completed and nearing schema for the town to agree with the concept of the project. That has not happened with the latest iteration. As Time is critical we have decided that they will be unable to take over this project.

> As landlords with many tenants we are acutely aware that the bridge project he is a fairly clear deadline for major construction downtown. We share the frustration of the town that this project is having trouble getting traction. We are even more frustrated however by unannounced and closed door meetings with the unknown outcomes involving people who have been hostile to the projects in the past. If this project is going to happen there is going to need to be a significant sense of community spirit toward a common goal. We are only asking for the same level of detail that was asked of us. Considering My family to be a barrier to this project represents a very significant double standard. We are simply asking for a level of clarity that any landowner and neighboring property owner would ask for.
