The Middlebury Fire Department underwent a complete facility upgrade in 2012/13. Time has gone by so fast and it is hard to believe that is has been eight years when all of this took place. At the time of construction, the Seymour street station installed a complete HVAC control system to monitor and control the heating and cooling of the facility. This System was installed by Temperature Controls of Vermont using WebCTRL Interface with version 5.0. Over the years of operation MFD has updated to our current version 6.5. This version will no longer be supported by Automated Logic after 07/09/2020. The current server is using Windows 7 and will no longer be supported and needs to be replaced with a new server using Windows 10 and new License.

The WebCTRL license upgrade and new server cost is \$2,350.00 and includes removing the existing server; uploading the existing WebCTRL database, converting it to v7.0, downloading it onto the new server, verifying proper operation of the license, installing the new server at the site and verifying connectivity to the control system.

We will provide an hour of onsite training to review the changes in the license upgrade.

Pat,

The WebCTRL interface license @ the Middlebury Fire Dept. is at version v6.5 which will no longer be supported by Automated Logic after 07/09/2020. The current version of WebCTRL is v7.0 which is a 1-step upgrade from the existing license: v6.5→v7.0 and is a complete rework of the WebCTRL software interface. The existing server at Middlebury FD with the WebCTRL license is out of date as well (Windows7) and requires an upgrade. The new server includes Windows10 operating system.

The WebCTRL license upgrade and new server cost is \$2,350.00 and includes removing the existing server; uploading the existing WebCTRL database, converting it to v7.0, downloading it onto the new server, verifying proper operation of the license, installing the new server at the site and verifying connectivity to the control system.

We will provide an hour of onsite training to review the changes in the license upgrade.
