Crash Analysis Methodology

Crash location priority rankings for intersections were developed using a variety of summary statistics, including traffic volumes, overall severity of crashes, and facility type. The inclusion of these components helps ensure that moneys earmarked for spot safety improvements are spent in the most efficient and cost-effective manner. The following tables provide the scoring criteria for the rankings of intersection analyses. The overall scoring for each intersection follows.


