

AUGUST 20, 2021

The Monett City Council met in regular session, Friday, August 20, 2021, at 9:30 a.m. at the Monett Park Casino, Highway 37 and 60, Monett, Missouri. Attendance was as follows: Mike Brownsberger – Mayor, Al Dohmen – Commissioner, Ken Gaspar – Commissioner, Christopher Weiner – City Administrator, Kristen Thompson – Deputy City Clerk, Kevin Sprengle – Sprengle Engineering, Melonie Roberts – Media, Georges Daoud – Police Chief, and two citizens.

Mayor Brownsberger called the meeting to order. The Minutes from the previous session dated July 20, 2021, were approved with a motion from Commissioner Dohmen and a second from Commissioner Gaspar. The following vote was recorded: Brownsberger – yes, Dohmen – yes, and Gaspar – yes.

Monthly expenditures in the amount of \$1,625,598.57 were presented for approval. Commissioner Gaspar made a motion to approve the expenses, and a second was heard from Commissioner Dohmen. The following vote was recorded: Brownsberger – yes, Dohmen – yes, and Gaspar – yes.

BILL 8878 FIRST AND SECOND READING: AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDMENT NO. 1 AND SUPPLEMENTAL AMENDMENT NO. 2 RELATING TO THE AIRPORT IMPORVEMENT PROJECT REFERED TO AS AIP PROJECT NO. 20-098B-1, ORDINANCE NO. 8851.

Bill 8878 was introduced for a first and then presented for a second reading. Christopher Weiner, City Administrator briefed the Council on contents and purpose of the bill. The meeting was opened for public discussion. The Council was asked the length and width of the new runway, Mike Brownsberger, Mayor answered with the original runway length/width as 75 ft x 5000 ft, with the new runway to be 100 ft x 6000 ft. No other comments were heard. Motion to approve Bill 8878 was made by Commissioner Dohmen and seconded by Commissioner Gaspar. The following vote was recorded: Brownsberger – yes, Dohmen – yes, Gaspar – yes.

RESOLUTION 8875: A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR DEMOLITION ODF A RESIDENTIAL DWELLING AND ACCESSORY STRUCTURE LOCATED AT 807 11TH STREET

Resolution 8875 was presented for approval of the lowest bid for demolition of a dwelling and accessory structure located at 807 11th Street. Two bids had been received: Vaughn Dirtworks, LLC for \$10,400.00 and Prime Contracting, Inc for \$11,700.00. Discussion was opened and Mike Brownsberger stated he has researched prior bids and with inflation, these bids were on target. Motion was made to accept the lowest bid by Vaughn Dirtworks by Commissioner Dohmen and seconded by Commissioner Gaspar. The following vote was recorded: Brownsberger – yes, Dohmen – yes, and Gaspar – yes.

RESOLUTION 8877: A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONETT AND PETE AND BETTY RAUCH

Resolution 8877 was presented for approval of an agreement for Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Monett and Pete and Betty Rauch. No discussion was heard from the public. Motion to approve was made by Mayor Brownsberger and seconded by Commissioner Gaspar. The following vote was recorded: Brownsberger – yes, Dohmen – yes, Gaspar – yes.

Upon conclusion of regular business, Christopher Weiner, City Administrator, requested a time be set for a work session. It was agreed upon the work session to be held on Wednesday, August 25th, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. at City Hall.

Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned with a motion from Commissioner Gaspar, and a second from Commissioner Dohmen. The following vote was recorded: Brownsberger – yes, Dohmen – yes, Gaspar – yes.
