

DECEMBER 17, 2021

The Monett City Council met in regular session, Friday, December 17, 2021, at 9:32 a.m. at the Monett Park Casino, Highway 37 and 60, Monett, Missouri. SAME AMOUNT AS ANY CITY SALES TAX IS REPEALED, REDUCED, OR RAISED; AND PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSION OF THE PROPOSAL TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY FOR THEIR APPROVAL AT THE GENERAL ELECTION CALLED AND TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON THE FIFTH (5TH) OF APRIL 2022.


